Darwin to Darwin - 23 Days

Day 1 (LD)

Departing Darwin, we will travel south to our first night's camp at Edith Fall where we will spend the afternoon relaxing by the waterfalls and rock pools whilst the more adventurous take a hike to the remote pools above the escarpment.

Day 2 (BLD)

Passing through the Township of Katherine we will head west towards the Kimberley and onto Timber Creek our camp for the night.

Day 3 (BLD)

This morning we make an early start for Lake Argyle stopping for morning tea in Gregory N.P before spending the afternoon cruising on the lake. Be sure to take your swimmers and camera

Day 4 (BLD)

Plan on an early start this morning and be prepared for a rough ride but it will all be worth it when we arrive in Purnululu N.P (aka the Bungle Bungles). After making camp we will spend the afternoon exploring the region.

Day 5 (BLD)

Today we will explore the areas surrounding our camp or perhaps take an optional scenic flight over these amazing formations

Day 6 (BLD)

After visiting Halls Creek and topping up on our supplies we'll make our way to Fitzroy Crossing and the Historic Crossing Inn our home for the night and a chance to relax by the river bank.

Day 7 (BLD)

Today we make our way to Geikie Gorge whilst taking a relaxing walk you should expect to spot Freshwater Crocodiles sunning themselves on the bank. After the morning at the gorge we continue along the Savannah way stopping at Fitzroy River for the night.

Day 8 (BLD)

After exploring the Fitzroy wetlands we head for the coastal township of Broome which will be our base for the next two nights. You will be sure to enjoy a relaxing drinks whilst watching the sunset over the Indian Ocean.

Day 9 (B)

Today is yours to enjoy as you wish. Your guide will give you some great suggestions of things to see and do. Just be sure to be back at camp by 4pm for the number one Broome must do, a Sunset Camel ride on Cable Beach.

Day 10 (BLD)

Today leads us to Derby, stopping at sights such as the Prison Boab Tree. On arriving at Derby there is an option to do a Scenic Flight over the Horizontal Waterfalls.

Day 11 (BLD)

Leaving the sealed road behind we enter Gibb River road country on our way to Windjana Gorge. Here we will take a short hike and perhaps spot some freshwater Croc's

Day 12 (BLD)

As we track deeper into the Kimberley on our way to Bell Gorge and Silent Grove you will wonder at the vastness and beauty of this amazing area. We will spend the afternoon relaxing by the gorge.

Day 13 (BLD)

Today will be another relaxing day of exploring the track with a stop off a Galvan Gorge on the way to Manning Gorge for a swim and our camp for the night.

Day 14 (BLD)

This morning we continue along the Gibb till we reach the Northern turnoff toward the Mitchell Plateau and our base for the night Drysdale Station.

Day 15 (BLD)

Today is sure to be a highlight of the trip as we reach the Mitchell Plateau and our base for the night. You will have time in the afternoon to take an optional scenic flight over the Falls or do some bush walking in the area surrounding our camp.

Day 16 (BLD)

Tonight we will camp at a working cattle station at Ellenbrae as we track back onto the Gibb River Road.

Day 17 (BL)

Today could well be an exciting day as we cross the Durack river one of the larger and more challenging crossing at the start of the season, on our way to Home Valley station.

Day 18 (BLD)

Not long after leaving the station we will cross the Pentecost River the Gibbs last challenge before meeting the sealed road that leads to Kununurra. We'll also visit the coastal township of Wyndham.

Day 19 (BD)

Today is spent at leisure either exploring Kununurra or relaxing at the campsite.

Day 20 (BLD)

Today we will visit Keep River N.P, Gregory N.P before making camp in Flora N.P for the night

Day 21 (BL)

A relaxed start today will have us heading for the Township Of Katherine then onto the Gorge where we will camp the night.

Day 22 (BLD)

This morning will be a very early wakeup in time to board the breakfast cruise on the gorge. We will stop over at Pine Creek on the way to Litchfield N.P our camp for the night.

Day 23 (BL)

Our last day will be a relaxing day which will see us leaving Litchfield after lunch arriving in Darwin early afternoon.
